
## Let's make Crumb Quilts

What are we going to be doing? Playing with our scraps to create fun and colorful crumb quilts. The steps I use to create these quilts will be shared. You can come and follow along or sew them based on your preferred method. Kits for making Row quilts will also be available if you like that style of quick quilt. Written Row quilt instructions are also available.

## Supplies needed

- Sewing machine-neutral thread (I use white or cream), scissors, pins if desired. If you are doing row quilts, you may want to have your walking foot on your machine.
- Fabric scraps-smallest I use is about 1.5 inches square but bring whatever you have or like. If you don't' have a lot of scraps, it's okay. There will be enough for this sewing session to share. Odd shaped scraps are fine also. Leftover blocks or squares from other quilts are also fine.
- Small cutting mat and rotary cutter
- Iron and ironing surface (if you want to iron by your sewing machine), There will be two
  ironing stations to share if you are not able to bring your own.

## Crumb Quilt examples





One type of crumb quilt is what I call a "cookie quilt". Paper coffee filters are used as a foundation and this creates round blocks that can be sewn to another fabric square. I will share an easy way to create these. See below for an example. If you want try this style of crumb block, supplies will be available.
