# **Frequently Asked Questions and General Information**

### Packaging blankets for drop off:

When packaging blankets for drop off, please review these guidelines:

- Put them in a plastic bag preferably that can be tied at the top (more than 1 in a bag is fine!)
- Put your name in the bag with the # of blankets included
- Put a piece of tape or note on the outside of the bag that says "Project Linus"
- Do not use a STRAIGHT pin to attach anything to the bag/blanket
- Do NOT use scented bags

**PINS!!!!** Please take extra care in checking your blankets for pins. We double check them, too, but we've had a few show up lately.

**Project Linus Patterns:** We usually have a FREE quilt pattern available for a limited time at the Project Linus (national) Store!! Go to <u>projectlinus.org</u> then click on STORE, Blanket Quilt Kits & Patterns, Instant Downloads, and then Other Patterns. Remember these free patterns are only available for a short time period. When the next one comes out, this one will be reasonably priced and still available in the store. **Project Linus Store:** Check out the store for Project Linus items to be purchased such as t-shirts, skip-stitch blades, pens, sewing notions, etc. <u>projectlinus.org</u> then click on STORE

If you THINK you've signed up, please check the bottom of your Kroger receipt. If it doesn't say Project Linus of East TN, please sign up again or ask for assistance at the Kroger Customer Service desk. We earn over \$400 a year thanks to the volunteers that sign up for this.

**Fabric and Yarn Donations:** We will not accept patterns/books/copies, crochet hooks/knitting needles. Fabric that is 5 years or older will not be accepted. Even if it's newer than 5 years, we will not accept fabric if it is musty, smells of smoke, or has animal hair. We also will not accept buttons, hooks, and other misc sewing supplies. We can not expect our drop off locations to store these items until we pick them up and we do not have individuals that generally want these items in their Project Linus volunteer work. Some of these items have been dropped off in boxes/bags that weigh 30 lbs or more. One box recently weighed over 50 lbs. Fabric should be in bags that weigh 10 lbs or less. Fabric should be in child friendly colors and prints

cotton/cotton blend/flannel/fleece. All fabric should be half yard pieces or larger. Yarn should be washable cotton blends and/or acrylic and in child friendly colors. Your help in adhering to these guidelines will be appreciated.

**Donations of Quilt Tops:** We understand that not all of you have the means to be able to get your quilt tops quilted for your donation to Project Linus. While we have the resources to do so, we will continue to do this. How can you help?

- Please make sure your quilt top is completely finished and stitching is secure.
- Backing should be provided with the quilt top. Backing should be at least 4" larger (5 or more inches is better) on all 4 sides (8" more than the total width and 8" more than the total length of the quilt top)
- If backing is in 2 pieces, please sew it together and press it before donation.
- Batting does NOT need to be provided. However, financial donations to cover the cost of batting will be greatly appreciated.
- Please provide binding to go with the quilt -2 % inch in width and a foot longer than the total of the 4 sides of the quilt top. Binding should be sewn together in one long piece.
- All materials should be folded neatly and put in one bag. Include a note with your name and "top to be quilted" in the bag.

We value the beautiful quilt tops you make for our children in traumatic situations. We also so appreciate our "long armers" Barb Knight and Leona Williams that are quilting for us and our "binding queen" Kim Mosier for all of their help.
