PICOT HEM BAMBOO STITCH BABY BLANKET

Cast on as many stitches as you want, remembering that the Bamboo Stitch is a multiple of 2 + 1, an uneven number.

Knit the first rows to make the Picot Hem.

Continue knitting in the Bamboo Stitch till the blanket is a few inches shorter than you want.

Knit another Picot Hem at the top.

Pick up stitches on the long sides of the blanket, one side at a time.

Work a Picot hem on each side.

PICOT HEM

Knit 5 rows stockinette.
PICOT ROW-with wrong side facing you, K1, YO, K2 tog
Knit 5 more rows stockinette.
Turn under and sew.

BAMBOO STITCH

Work on a multiple of 2 plus 1 (uneven).
Row 1 K1, *YO, K 2, Pass the YO the 2 knitted stitches, repeat from * Row 2 Purl all stitches.
Repeat these 2 rows for pattern.
