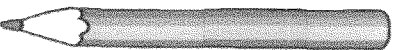




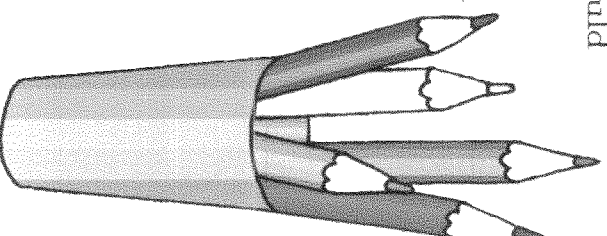
## WATERCOLOR BOOKMARKS

Watercolor Paper - Cold Press 140 lb. (5" X 2 1/2" pc. for project)  
Watercolor Pencils - Derwent Water Colour Pencil  
Stamp Pad - Permanent Ink - StazOn Jet Black  
Various Stamps  
Round Brushes - # 1 or #3 Round  
Container for Water, Paper Towels  
Magnetic Tape w/ Sticky Back

We are going to make a bookmark using watercolor paper and stamping it with permanent ink. We will color it with pencils (watercolor), moisten with water and blend out for a watercolor effect.



Let's begin with stamping a design on the front of water color paper (on the bottom edge). Then crease to fold in half. Finish crease with a sharp edge.  
You will color with the pencils in the shadow areas (don't fill the entire space) of the design. After using the pencils, you will need a # 1 -#3 round brush to begin moistening the colored areas. Dip your brush in water and then blot before going to your bookmark. You can continue blotting as needed on your paper towel if too much water is picked up or you would like to lighten an area. When done you can then stamp a saying inside, add magnetic tape and we have a clever bookmark. Easy and something everyone can do. Nice gifts to put in a birthday or get well card. Enjoy!
