

Amazing Jelly Roll Quilt

Video and photo instructions for block technique and assembly by Missouri Star Quilt Company and Three Dudes Quilting.

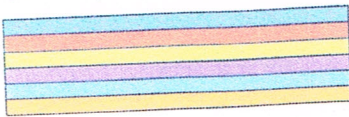

Materials Needed to make blocks: (Border, backing, binding and batting measurements not included.)
1 jelly roll or 40 - 2 1/2" x WOF assorted fabric strips

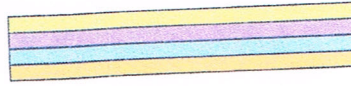
Instructions are for the large block quilt with those for the small block quilt in (parenthesis)

You will use one jelly roll for either the large or small blocks.

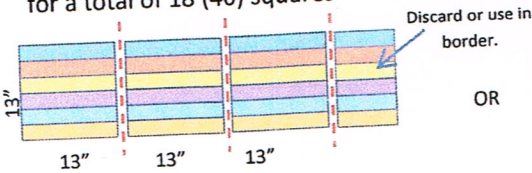
1. Sew six (four) 2 1/2" jelly roll strips together into sets. You will create six (ten) strip sets from the 40 (40) jelly roll strips.



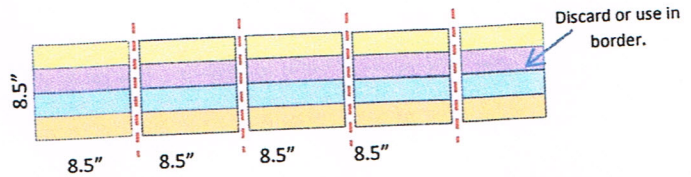

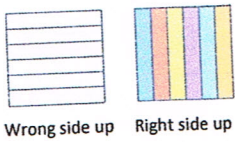
2. Measure height of the strip set and cut each strip set into squares. You should get at least three (four) squares per strip set for a total of 18 (40) squares



OR



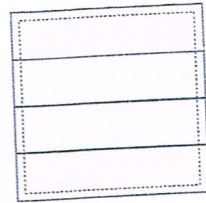
3. For each block, lay two squares on top of each other, right sides together – one square with strips going horizontally and the other square with strips going vertically.



Place squares on top of each other, right sides together, one vertical, one horizontal.

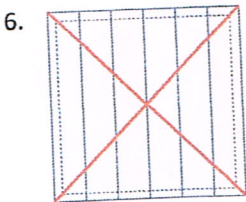


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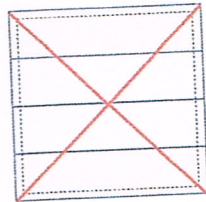


4. Sew 1/4" around all cut edges.

5. Cut square on both diagonals (red line) creating 4 blocks. It helps to use a spinning cutting board.



OR



7. Press block open and position the 4 blocks (either the 6 strip (left) or 4 strip (right)) as pictured.
